Proposals will be evaluated using the following rubric:

1. Cost of eligible equipment.....40 points

Cost of the e-rate eligible equipment in the proposal.

2. Compatibility with district’s existing devices and software.....20 points

The district has spent significant resources to standardize our network devices and management software. Therefore compatibility with these existing devices and management software is very important. Zero (0) points will be awarded for non-compatible devices, and twenty (20) points will be awarded for full compatibility.

3. Product features and capabilities.....20 points

All documented features and capabilities of the proposed devices will be evaluated and points awarded as such. Points will not be awarded for features and capabilities that are not included in the cost of the devices as proposed.

4. Louisiana state contract preference.....20 points

The district prefers to purchase using the Louisiana State Contract when possible. Zero (0) points will be awarded for proposals that *are not* based on the Louisiana State Contract, and twenty (20) points will be awarded for proposals that *are* based on the Louisiana State Contract.
